Shenandoah County Department of Fire and Rescue would like to take this time to advise the community that new fire lanes will be established at all three school campuses. Access to and around school property has been a growing concern both from volunteer fire and rescue agencies and the community. One of the key elements in providing good timely service is having the ability to gain access to the area in need.

In order to insure that fire lanes will be maintained free of vehicles, an ordinance has been created to assist with the enforcement. These ordinances will allow Law Enforcement to write a fire lane violation of up to \$50 and/or towing of the vehicle at the owners expense.
